



They don't get paid much and they have no legal rights, no security and are often abused.

In Year 9 we have looked at the themes of globalisation and its links to modern day slavery.

Companies like Nike, H&M and Chanel have all been accused of using modern day slaves as free or cheap labour. Workers ...many women and children ...are paid very little for 14-hour days. This keeps wages low and profits high.


Year 9 carried out case studies, each group had one type of modern-day slavery.


