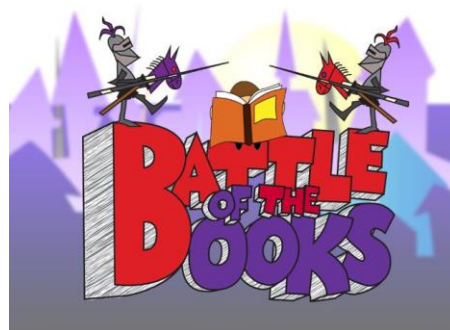

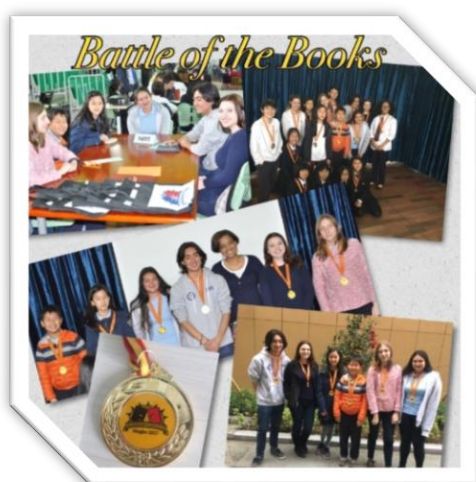
Battle of the Books Awards

Battle of the Books is a book-related competition for students in Year 5 to Year 13. Students are quizzed about books that they have read from the designated Battle of the Books reading list. Teams from NBIS were made up of two primary students from Years 5 and 6, two lower secondary students from Years 7-9, and two upper secondary students from Years 10-13. This year, NBIS entered three teams for the first time because of the overwhelming interest from students.



Each year students who decide to compete in Battle of the Books must read 10 books per section. This year the number of books were reduced to 8 because of the unavailability of some of the books. Since there are two students in each team per section, the students can choose to read half the books each or they can read all the books. Students prepared for Battle of the Books by independently making notes, making a poster boards and character sketches about main characters, the important events, the settings for each title. Unfortunately, due to sudden lock down of the school, we weren't able to have a practise run in school; however, the students were prepared!

In 2020, Battle of the Books was cancelled because of Covid and in **2021 NBIS returned stronger than ever to win the Battle of the Books.**

Because we were unable to visit the Georgia School Campus, we held an online Battle of the Books Competition. The competition took place on April 15th on zoom. The students joined WeChat groups to discuss their answers on a separate call while they viewed the questions on their computers via Zoom. After the students discussed their answers on the WeChat call, one member of the group compiled the list and sent to Ms. Froome to be judged. The MC of the competition was Ms. Darcie Flansburg, who is the Head of Secondary of GSN and the judges were Ms. Froome, Head of English at NBIS and Mr. Darren who is the librarian at GSN.

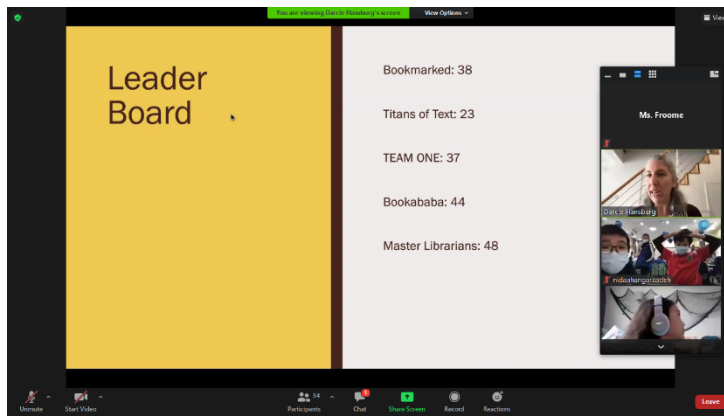

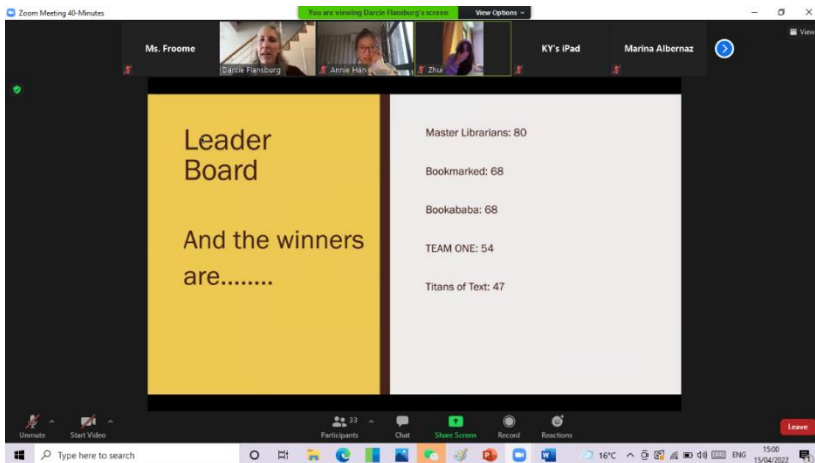
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Master Librarians took an early lead during the competition.

We talked about the epidemic prevention this week. On Monday, everyone took a covid test by throat-swab. Children took turns to do it and looked quite calm!

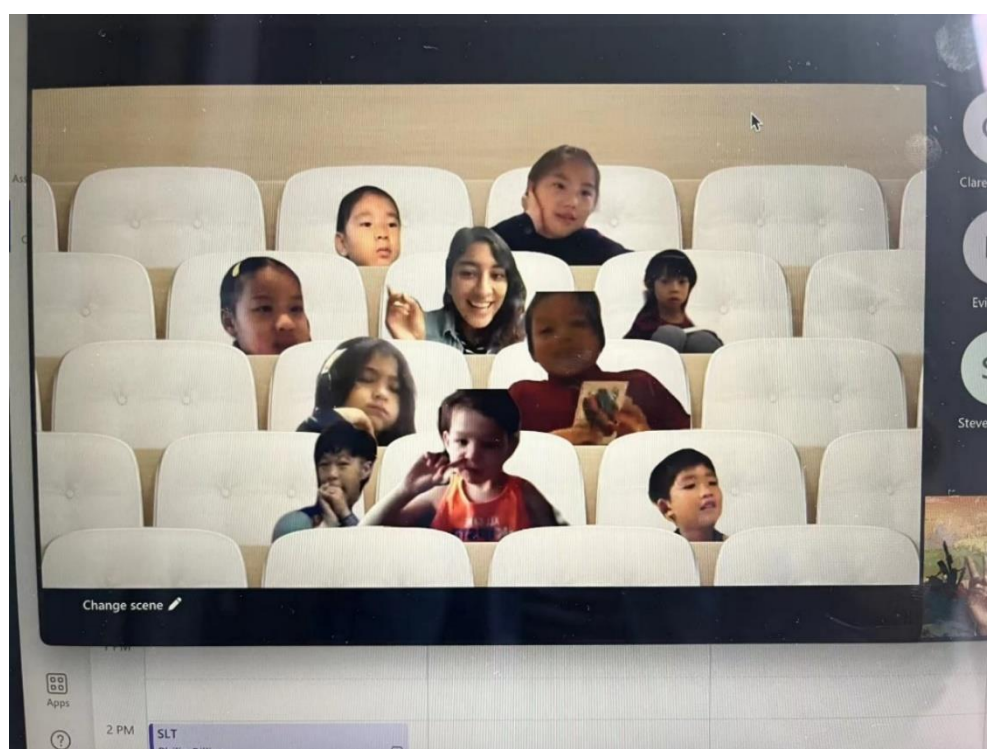
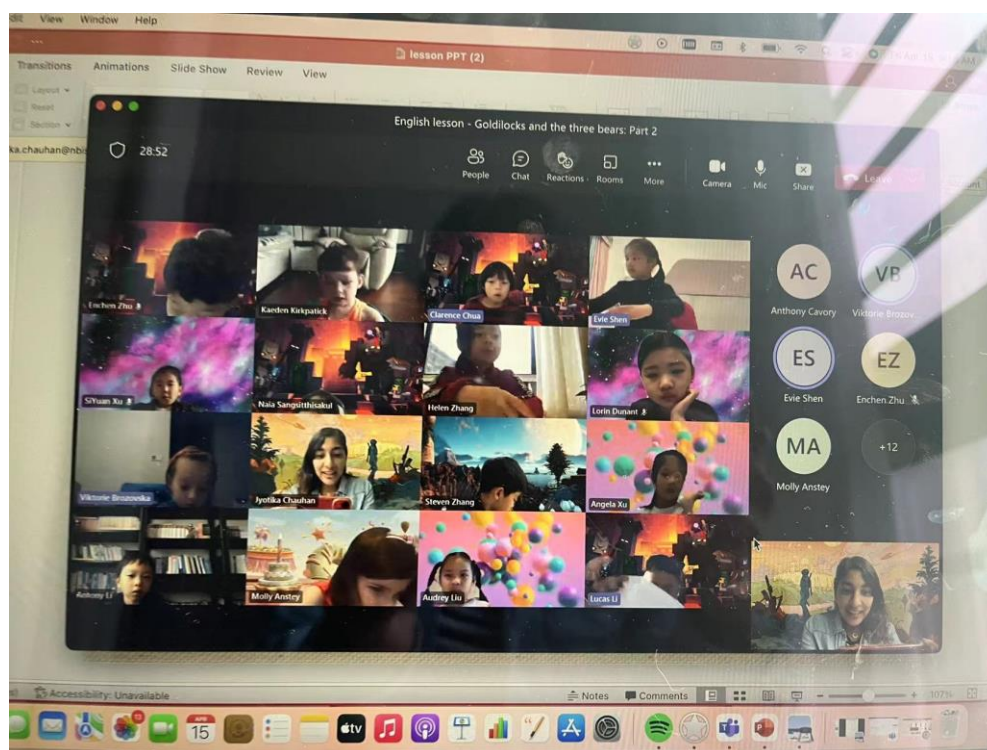
